The day off for participants is **Monday 27 September** – why not choose from the following day trip options to make the most of your time in Tanzania:



Day trip to watch marine turtles hatch on the beaches in the south of Dar es Salaam. We will collect you from your preferred location, and drive you to south beach. You will arrive in plenty of time to take a short walk along the beach to the nest site and watch the baby turtles emerge. Your guide and the local Sea Sense conservation officer will give you lots of interesting turtle facts. You can then enjoy the white sandy beaches for a short while before going back to Dar.

Cost: \$50 adult, \$20 child.
40% donated to Sea Sense, a community based NGO supporting turtle conservation in Tanzania. You can also **adopt a nest** for \$50 to help conservation efforts further.
Includes: Return transport from Dar, guide & refreshments.
(Note: scheduling of hatching is dependent on mother nature! We can confirm if a nest is ready one week to 2 days beforehand)



Join us for a **sightseeing day around Dar es Salaam**. Starting with a guided walk through the centre of town visiting the historical sites and seeing evidence of German and British Colonial rule. We will then go to the National Museum and after a picnic lunch in the Botanical Gardens, we will take you to a local craft market and wood carving workshop where we'll help you haggle for mementos of your stay in Dar.

Cost: \$40 per person
Includes: Guide and transport for the whole day including collection and return to your hotel or DYC, picnic lunch and refreshments, all taxes.



For those with no time to have a safari after your trip, relax in the bush with a **day trip safari in Mikumi National Park**. Fly from Dar, landing at 9.15am and enjoy a morning and afternoon game drive with picnic lunch to maximise your time observing wildlife. Our guides will take you to the best viewing locations and get you right up close to Africa's most famous residents including elephant, buffalo, lion, giraffe, wildebeest, zebra; and is also excellent for birding enthusiasts. You will have a full day in the park leaving at about 4pm.

Cost: \$460 per person
Includes: All taxes, return flights, airport transfers, picnic lunch with refreshments, park fees, 4WD safari converted vehicles with expert driver and guide.

As a flavour of what is possible:

Ruaha National Park: 4 day Adventure Fly Camp

Prices from \$1,195 per person

- Day 1:** Leave Dar in the early morning and drive through farming villages, the southern highlands and into Ruaha. Before dinner, relax at the lodge swimming pool with a cocktail as the elephants come to the waterhole for a drink.
- Day 2:** After breakfast, walk from the lodge into your wilderness fly camp with our armed guide. Learn how to track wildlife and get an intimate view of the game as you walk. The camp crew will collect your gear from the lodge - it will be ready for you in your safari tents. After lunch, have a game drive until sunset for a different perspective. Return to camp and have a hearty dinner prepared by our cooks.
- Day 3:** Chose from walking safaris or game drives with a picnic. After dinner go on an exhilarating night game drive to spot leopard, porcupine and other animals most active in the dark. Return to the camp and relax around the fire with your guide helping you to spot star constellations. Listen to the wildlife around you on your last night in the bush.
- Day 4:** Leave after an early breakfast and head back to Dar. Alternatively, you can extend the day with more game drives and fly back to Dar, or add on an extra day to break your road journey with a farm stay at boutique cottages on a working chilli farm.

Selous Game Reserve: 4 day Wilderness Camp

Prices from \$1,250 per person

- Day 1:** Leave Dar in the morning and drive south to the Selous. Arrive for an afternoon game drive through the park towards camp. After orientation and a well earned hot shower, sit around the camp fire with a refreshing drink and a delicious dinner.
- Day 2:** After some breakfast, explore the different landscapes across the expanse of the reserve on your game drives. We can prepare picnic lunches for you so you maximise your time observing wildlife. Return to camp and have a hearty dinner prepared for you by our cooks.
- Day 3:** In the morning go on a walking safari and learn how to identify signs and tracks from wildlife. Return to camp for lunch and have an afternoon and sunset game drive. After dinner, challenge your guide to name all the animals he can hear around the camp.
- Day 4:** Leave after an early game drive and some breakfast and head back to Dar. Alternatively, you can extend the day with more game drives and fly back to Dar.

Southern Circuit Highlights: 7 days to explore Mikumi, Udzungwa Mountains and Ruaha National Parks

Prices from \$1,870 per person

- Day 1:** Leave Dar in the morning and drive to Mikumi. Arrive for lunch and an afternoon game drive through the park. Return to your lodge and watch the game pass by in front of you as you dine.
- Day 2:** After some breakfast, explore the park some more with a full day game drive stopping at the hippo pool for your picnic. Head back to the lodge for sundowners and dinner.
- Day 3:** In the morning drive a short distance to the Udzungwa Mountains. Hike up to waterfalls and look out for rare birds and endemic primates. Spend the afternoon exploring the park on foot and stay in the Udzungwas that night at a guesthouse.
- Day 4:** Leave after an early breakfast and drive to Ruaha. Have a bird walk before dinner at your lodge, or relax in the swimming pool with giraffe, kudu, warthog and elephant coming up to the waterhole.
- Day 5:** After breakfast, walk from the lodge into your wilderness fly camp with our armed guide. Learn how to track wildlife and get close to the game for an intimate view. After lunch, go on a game drive until sunset to get some more amazing photos. Return to camp for a hearty dinner prepared by our cooks.
- Day 6:** Chose from walking safaris or game drives with a picnic. After dinner go on an exhilarating night game drive to spot leopard, porcupine and other animals most active at night time. Return to the camp and relax around the fire with your guide helping you to spot star constellations. Listen to the wildlife around you on your last night in the bush.
- Day 7:** Leave after an early breakfast and head back to Dar. Alternatively, you can extend the day with more game drives and fly back to Dar, or add on an extra day to break your road journey with a farm stay at boutique cottages on a working chilli farm.

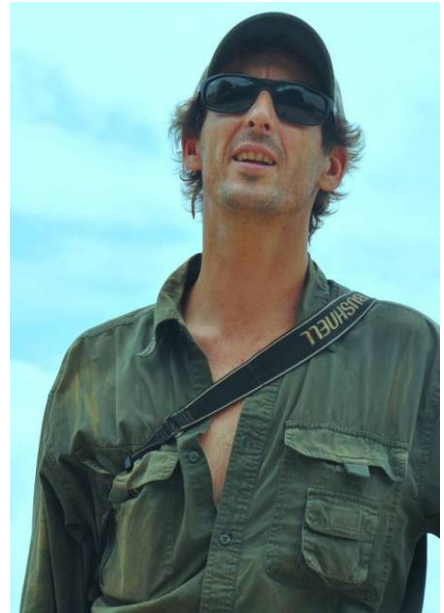


Authentic Tanzania

Sven grew up in Tanzania having moved here from Germany when he was four. He was educated in Dar es Salaam, went to a boarding school in Germany and attended University in the UK where he attained a degree in Tourism and Sport. He speaks fluent German, English and Kiswahili.

From a very early age Sven knew he wanted to work in the bush. His first opportunity was setting up and managing hunting camps in 1996. He then switched to the photographic side and he spent several seasons working at lodges in the various National Parks and Game Reserves in Tanzania. He was involved in everything from camp management, to setting up mobile fly camps, and he also began guiding. Realising he'd found his calling so he attained guiding certificates during six months living wild in the bush in Zimbabwe, Botswana, Namibia, and Zambia. He also has professional guiding licences from South Africa and Kenya.



Sven has a wealth of experience in professional guiding and he is most at home under canvas. In 2005 Sven joined photographic safari company Authentic Tanzania as a Director. He pioneered wilderness camping in remote locations in the southern circuit allowing guests to observe wildlife close up and get a real feel for the bush with nobody else around. He is a good marksman, and groups are in safe hands as Sven leads them on exhilarating walking safaris and night drives to get yet another intimate perspective of the Tanzanian bush.

Sven is committed to conservation and has developed eco-tourism projects with NGOs and community groups to improve environmental education and awareness of wildlife management. Through these endeavours he helps to ensure that funds raised from tourism are directed to those community groups active in the conservation and protection of endangered species.
